HALF AND HALF BALANCE

2022 half-and-half report: You will find below the table of figures for the sale of halves and halves and for pitch tickets.

Half and Half: So far, we have accumulated \$707.50 in half and half this season. Added to the balance from last year and the expenses related to the barbecue dinner, there remains a balance of \$1306.56 in the account. Note that the campsite paid for the Latino show. There are still a few activities left this year. We are very happy to see that you are participating in large numbers.

Site Tickets: We are pleased to announce that we have so far accumulated \$312.00 in site ticket sales. A great new initiative from our leisure team which seems to be very popular. The amount raised will be ENTIRELY donated to one or more lucky people, in order to reduce the amount of the 2023 invoice.

UPDATE – LEISURE :

I thought it would be good to take a few minutes, in order to make a small update on the current situation of leisure (Committee / Team), since some may be asking questions about how things are going this year. or seem unhappy.

When the 3 committee members resigned last year, the social committee was dissolved. We recovered the sums and had the winter to get all the necessary information in order to modify the leisure management procedures according to our requirements, and the information that we obtained, since I had the chance this winter, to participate in a zoom meeting with our association with several campground owners, on the management of leisure activities in the various campgrounds in Quebec and on the advantages and disadvantages of the different forms of leisure management (Autonomous Committee vs. Managed Committee by owners). We had the opportunity to share our experience between owners in order to help us make the best decision, based on the experience lived in the past, our experience as former campers who have already been part of committees, but also according to what we want to have in our campsite and what we believe is best for everyone (campers/travelers, seasonal and owners)..

Decision :

Due to the complexity and inconveniences related to the formation of a social committee (creation of an NPO, business register, assembly, votes, appointments, minutes, etc.) but also in order to keep control over finances of the committee, to have a say in the decisions, the activities, and the brand image of our campsite so that these are offered as much to seasonal as to traveling campers and finally to avoid conflicts between campers, we have decided to manage the recreation committee ourselves rather than having a committee managed by seasonal.

This is why we met at the beginning of the season, people who wanted to get involved and we were pleasantly surprised to see that +/- 20 people wanted to get involved and/or give their time.

Half-Half: Nathalie Pitre and Lucie Fortier: Nathalie, responsible for the sale of half-half, accompanied by a new person each week. Lucie, responsible for compiling with Nathalie the sums accumulated so that they proceed to the live draw on Facebook. Lucie compiles the income accumulated each week and brings the part belonging to the Campsite for recreation.

Communications: It is our new seasonal Déitane Raymond, from field 19, who takes care of the majority of communications with the seasonal with her nice design and her beautiful ideas.

Dinner/Show: We (owners/families) had organized the Latino Show event and a little at the last minute, our volunteers got their hands dirty to organize a barbecue dinner which was a success. Thanks to Caroline (39) who took care of finding and ordering the grilled meats and to the team of volunteers who served the meal (Nancy and Patrick (11), Lucie and Claude (47) and Nathalie and Laurent (38) , and finally to Marie-France and Alain (48) who came to help pick up after the event). I hope I didn't forgot anyone.

Camper's Christmas: Caroline (39) and her small group answered this winter's call, in which I asked if you wanted to organize an event with a small group, this in order to have as many people as possible who get involved and that there is more variety of ideas, avoiding a single small group to manage and organize everything. They will therefore organize a beautiful day for you on the occasion of the Christmases that we have lost due to the COVID.

Bottles/Cans: Thanks to Nancy and Patrick (11), Caroline and Daniel (6) and Lucie and Claude (47) for helping us sort and sell cans and bottles. These sums will be used to continue to offer you surprises.

Daniele (14) who sold the grill tickets. Our new seasonal Denis du (4) who will organize the rally with Laurent (38), as well as all the participants who accompany Nathalie every week for the sale of tickets. Sorry if I forgot any.

We are really happy to see that we have so many volunteers this year and that the majority of our campers seem to enjoy the activities.
